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
Introduction


How to book on courses

Where payment is required, you will be asked to pay via the secure online checkout within Churchsuite at point of booking.

Charges

All the training courses and pre-recorded videos **are included** within the core service contribution payment made by schools. Conferences carry a small charge, which is reduced for 'CSC schools'.

'CSC' refers to those Church Schools who contribute to our annual 'Core Services' scheme.

'Non-CSC' are all other schools.

Please note that all prices exclude VAT; invoices will be sent in the name of our trading company, 'Ethos School Improvement Limited'.

Booking and non-attendance

Booking is essential for all courses. This allows us to prepare appropriately for all those booked on to the course.

Participants are asked to give at least 48 hours' notice if they need to cancel their place, especially if lunch is being provided. **All** 'no-shows' incur a charge to cover associated costs.


