

SUPERVISION CONTRACT

BETWEEN (Group Supervisor)

AND (Director of Mission and Ministry) Neville Emslie

This is the contract between the above-named Group Supervisor and the Director of Mission and Ministry for supervision in groups of pastoral supervisors.

The purpose of this contract is to formalise the relationship of the Group Supervisors as associate members of the Mission and Ministry team of the Diocese of Canterbury, through the Director of Mission and Ministry, and thus to establish the relationship as one of resource, support, encouragement and appreciation.

These are the terms of the agreed contract.

The Group Supervisor agrees to

1. attend a meeting of Group Supervisors for Group Supervision Practitioner Development twice a year
2. be in supervision by agreement with the Director of Mission and Ministry
3. take on one supervision group initially and thereafter to liaise with the Director of Mission and Ministry about taking on further groups as necessary/according to capacity
4. fulfil the contracted arrangements they enter into with their group supervisees
5. facilitate group supervision generally every 6-8 weeks with breaks in the months of August and December

The Director of Mission and Ministry agrees to

1. be reasonably available for enquiries regarding practical and confidential matters to do with the work of pastoral supervision.
2. appoint a mutually agreed facilitator if need be to help us resolve the issue if a problem arises between the Group Supervisor and the Director of Mission and Ministry
