



Talk: what does Jesus look like?

And in fact, if we are honest, none of knows what Jesus looks like. We might know what we want him to look like, but the truth is, is that mostly we just don't know...

The only help we get anywhere, is one little statement in the New Testament, and another little statement in the Old Testament.

In the New Testament, we hear these words

he made himself nothing
by taking the very nature of a servant,
being made in human likeness.
And being found in appearance as a man,

Philippians 2:7-8

And in the Old Testament, in a prophecy, we are told

he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him.

Isaiah 53:2

So, in other words, all we know about Jesus' appearance, is that he was a man who wasn't anything special to look at. He wasn't particularly good looking, and he wasn't particularly ugly.

He was just a standard, non-descript looking bloke.

So, if we don't know what Jesus looked like, then what is important about Jesus?

Well, the truth is, is that it's what he did that, is so astonishing and so amazing. It's what he gave up that is so humbling...

What Jesus achieved for the whole human race, is what is really important. That's what's important for you and me.
