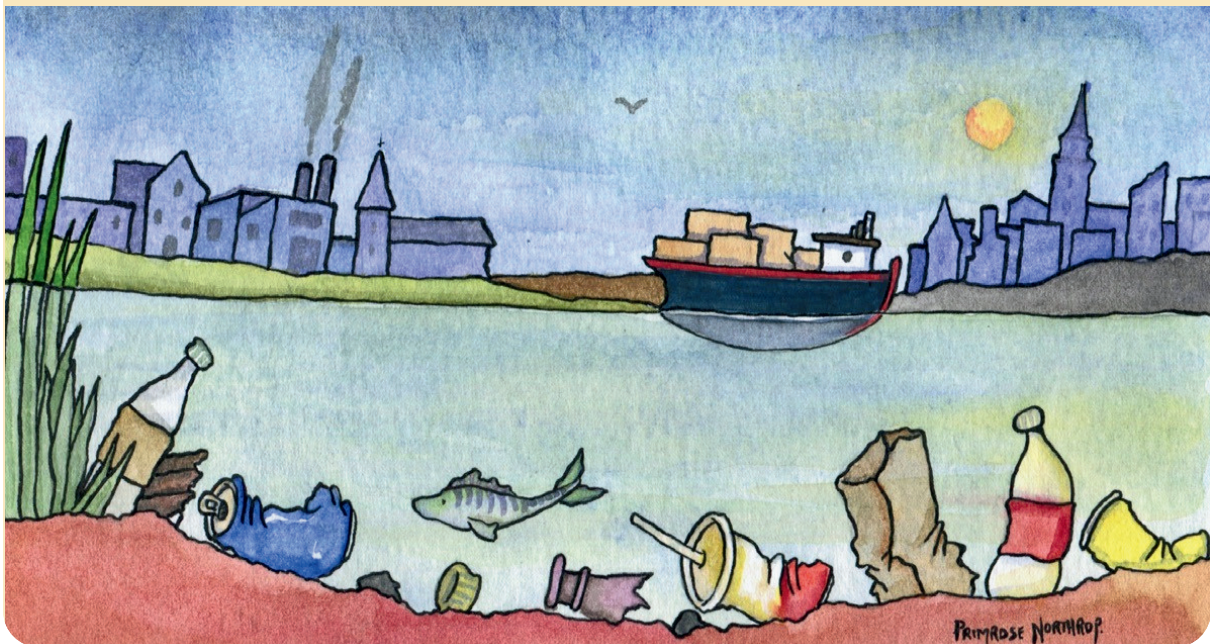
SEASON OF CREATION — FLOWING FREE
